## UK REACH Statement

EU REACH has been brought into UK law under the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018.

UK REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of Chemicals) Regulations (EC regulation number 1907/2006) came into force as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021 following the UK's withdrawal from the EU and subsequent transition period, and has retained the key principles of the EU REACH Regulation (UK statutory instrument 2020 No. 1577).

The aims of UK REACH is to provide a high level of protection to human health and the environment from the use of chemicals and to ensure people who place chemicals onto the market are responsible for managing the risks associated with the use of those chemicals.

To the best of its knowledge, Sonifex does not manufacture or import chemical substances defined within UK REACH Regulations.

In the course of manufacturing, Sonifex may use chemical substances which are commonly found within the electronics industry. Uses include for cleaning, vapour phase reflow, and screen printing.

Sonifex is therefore deemed a 'downstream user' and registration is not required.

Sonifex remains committed to be as environmentally friendly as possible and are part of many schemes to remove waste safely and responsibly.
